This new designation will add to a growing suite of WELL ratings that include the WELL Health-Safety Rating and the forthcoming WELL Health Equity Rating. Each can be achieved as a stand-alone designation or milestone along the way to WELL Bronze, Silver, Gold or Platinum Certification. For WELL Portfolio participants, achieving these ratings will contribute to their WELL Score.
